

The Accessibility Team provides accessibility expertise across the project to improve the accessibility of WordPress core and resources.

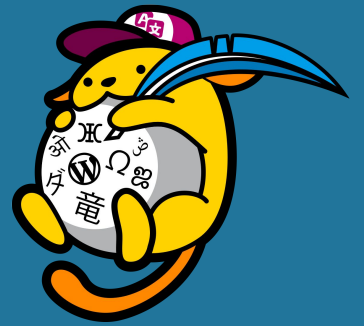
